

### **Conservation Agreement Structure**










# Required Structure for SAFE Conservation Agreements






- Creation of <u>Village Development Fund</u> to receive direct payments from the project.

### Why Village Groups?


- Village Groups and Demonstration Activities will become the focus for the SAFE Project through Conservation Agreements.
- Conservation Agreements must benefit all people in the village, not just some people.
- The Village Groups will serve as the arms of the Village Authorities, VDFs and VDCs.
- Village Groups are more equitable than providing services to individuals.




















# Possible Flow of Direct Payments from SAFE Project to Communities
