Definitions & Acronyms

Economic & social	Clearly benefiting, in terms of selling livestock to the auctions, getting money and feeding their families. People have a secondary income through livestock management that came about the conservation efforts. People have built better and stronger houses from the income they received from selling livestock. Through alien plant removal, members of the community were hired which allowed them to purchase food and clothes for their families.
Ecological	Clearly benefiting in terms of clean water for human consumption and livestock grazing, more birdlife in the area, the conservation also helps people remove alien invasive plants and leave the veld much more clear and better looking.
Incentives	A list of things that WWF organises for a community depending on what they need e.g. a management plan, firefighting training with equipment to protect their grasslands, alien invasive plants training, small grant from UNDP, etc.
