Before we moved out from Hugi Kha Khaeng Protected area, we were chemically mono-cropping which usually attracts conflict with wild life. With the animals eating our crops, we kept repeating losses and build debts. But after deciding to move out from protected area and into the buffer with 1/10 less area, we begin to see hope and future by doing variety of organic vegetable agriculture. We stop using chemical pesticides that harmfully effects the soil, water, wildlife, our health and the consumer's

We won't return to the dangerous-poverty life cycle again.




I'ts a great way for stable income


Before being involved with UNDP Tiger Project, I was one of the people who relied on the forest for income. But after I participated.


While human and wildlife live separately, it will bring richness to nature and environment.
